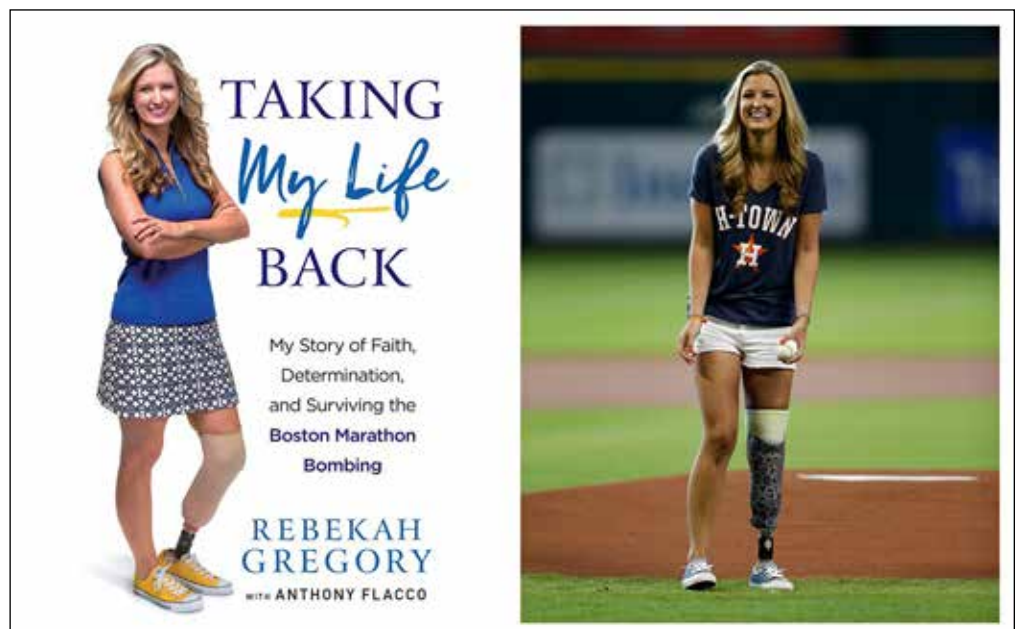

Nominees are separated into four categories of hospitals between 0-99 beds, between 100-250 beds, between 251-499 beds and over 500 beds. Two recipients are selected from each category and receive cash awards. Additional honors include the Community Service Award, System Employee Award, Physician Award, Volunteer Award, Preceptor Award and the Rex McRae Scholarship.
