DIVE INTO 5 Readmissions Topic: CMS is challenging each hospital to interview 5 readmission patients a month for the next 3 months to deep dive into reasons why the patients are being readmitted

Please let Patti or Michele know what you are finding out when interviewing the patients This should help you prioritize what is needed to help your patients avoid a 30 day readmission
