HRET HIIN had another successful roadshow in sunny Irving, Texas. DFW Hospital Council Foundation hosted the HRET team as they focused on two key themes: high reliability organizations and rules of engagement. Fran Griffin of the Institute for Healthcare Improvement (IHI) shared the five characteristics of a highly reliable organizations and how to begin implementing these principles in daily hospital work. Chris Hund, Quality Director of HRET, tied the TeamSTEPPs principles into rules of engagement and joy in work through interactive discussions and exercises. All participants took the opportunity to share their #whyimhiin stories which provided meaningful engagement and insights into what motivates them to do the work that they do to increase patient safety and quality of care
