Lean Six Sigma Yellow Belt Classes



It is time to get your teams together. This class will be: November 6 &7th -Richland Hills November 8 & 9th -Central Texas

- Teams of 2-3 people from the same hospital (When picking your team- think about who is passionate about a project/topic and who would commit to complete the follow-up. Can be bedside care giver, charge nurse, supervisor, manager or director- don't forget your ancillary departments)
- Each team must pick an approved project from the HIIN topics
- Class is 1.5 days to learn techniques. Check in calls for progress updates and coaching (for 30 days) and a 20-minute presentation to the group and your executive team at the end to graduate and get your Yellow Belt.

If you team is outside of a 60-mile radius from Richland Hills, a hotel will be provided for you. I must confirm all hotel rooms by October 23.

Class size is 30. Once the class fills up you will be put on a waiting list
